

# NEPALI (NEPAL)

## NEPAL 1121 - Elementary Nepali I (4 Credits)

This course is designed for beginners with no prior knowledge of the Nepali language. It focuses on developing essential language skills—speaking, listening, reading, and writing—through the use of culturally relevant materials and texts. Emphasis is placed on foundational grammar structures and practical communication. Students will also be introduced to the Devanagari script for reading and writing in Nepali.

## NEPAL 1122 - Elementary Nepali II (4 Credits)

This course is a continuation of NEPAL 1121: Elementary Nepali I. It builds upon foundational skills, with continued emphasis on basic grammar and the four core language competencies—speaking, listening, reading, and writing. Students will engage with culturally relevant and contemporary materials to further develop their proficiency in Nepali.

## NEPAL 2201 - Intermediate Nepali I (3 Credits)
