WOLOF 1117 - Elementary Wolof I (4 Credits)

This course is a basic introduction to the Wolof language. It aims to build students' basic understanding of the sentence structure of the language. It will enhance your command of complex grammar, written forms, and oral expression. Course materials will incorporate various text types, including tales, poetry, literature, and multimedia, such as television and radio. At the end of the course, you will present an analysis of an authentic oral or written text to an audience, formulate a position surrounding the text, and respond spontaneously to questions.
