As you prepare for the next steps in the process, these tools will also support you in drafting a summary to describe the invention to key stakeholders, exploring different commercialization pathways for inventions, and mastering best practices for navigating each pathway. Finally, you'll have the opportunity to examine recommendations for creating an invention management system for your team and for how to foster an invention management mindset. By the end of this program, you will have developed insight into processes to better create and execute the management of commercially viable inventions.
