- PUBPOL Special studies courses (PUBPOL 4000, PUBPOL 4010, PUBPOL 4020, PUBPOL 4030) do <u>not</u> count towards the PAM minor.
- Policy Analysis and Management (PAM), Public Policy (PUBPOL) and Health Care Policy (HCP) majors are not eligible to complete the Policy Analysis and Management minor.
- Keeping track of courses required and completed is the student's responsibility. Students will not be assigned a Brooks School advisor.
