## **Minor Requirements**

- A minor in Sanskrit Studies may be achieved by meeting these requirements:
- Demonstrate language proficiency by completing SANSK 2251 Intermediate Sanskrit I or any higher-level Sanskrit course.
- Take a minimum of five Sanskrit or Sanskrit-related courses, including at least one 3000-level or higher-level course, and totaling no fewer than 18 credits.
